TERMS & CONDITIONS

•YOUTH 2000 RETREATS ARE PROVIDED FOR THOSE BETWEEN THE AGES OF 16-35 YEARS. ANYONE OUTSIDE THIS AGE BRACKET MAY ATTEND BY DAY ONLY BUT CANNOT STAY ONSITE AT NIGHT.

•THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL AND RECREATIONAL DRUGS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN. THOSE WHO HAVE, OR ARE SUSPECTED TO HAVE, CONSUMED ANY SUCH SUBSTANCES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO REMAIN ONSITE AND WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.

•PARTICIPANTS ARE ASKED TO MAINTAIN AN ACCEPTABLE STANDARD OF BEHAVIOUR AND ACT IN A LAW-ABIDING, MATURE AND HONEST MANNER. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN THE PARTICIPANT BEING ASKED TO LEAVE.

•ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST REGISTER AT THE EVENT AND ARE REQUIRED TO INFROM REGISTRATION WHEN THEY ARE LEAVING THE EVENT.

•PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION IS REQUIRED BY ALL THOSE ATTENDING OUR EVENTS. THOSE WHO ARE UNDER 18 MUST ALSO PROVIDE A PARENTAL CONSENT FORM. ALL INFORMATION PROVIDED TO YOUTH 2000 MUST BE ACCURATE. A PARTICIPANT MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE IF THEY WILLINGLY PROVIDE FALSE INFORMATION. ANY UNDER 18 ASKED TO LEAVE WILL HAVE THEIR NEXT OF KIN OR PERSON WITH PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY CONTACTED TO COLLECT THEM. WHERE THIS IS NOT POSSIBLE THE RELEVANT SERVICES WILL BE CONTACTED.

•SEPARATE ACCOMMODATIONS ARE PROVIDED FOR MALES AND FEMALES. PLEASE DO NOT ENTER AREAS THAT ARE NOT ALLOCATED TO YOU.

•ACCESS TO THE OUTER EXTENDS OF THE GROUNDS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN AND PARTICIPANTS SHOULF REMAIN IN THE RETREAT PROGRAMME AND ORGANISED ACTIVITIES AT ALL TIMES.

•EACH PERSON IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN PERSONAL ITEMS. YOUTH 2000 IRELAND WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE/LIABLE FOR ANY PROPERTY LOST STOLEN OR DAMAGED.

•PARTICIPANTS ARE OBLIGED TO PARTAKE IN THE FULL PROGRAMME THROUGHOUT THE DURATION OF THE RETREAT.

•U18'S ARE NOT PERMITTED TO LEAVE THE RETREAT AREA UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES WITHOUT THE YOUTH 2000 SAFEGUARDING OFFICER RECEIVING PERMISSION FROM A PARENT OR GUARDIAN.

•U18'S ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BE ALONE IN THE GROUNDS OF THE RETREAT VENUE, THEY MUST BE IN GROUPS OF NO LESS THAN 3 AND AGAIN ACCESS TO THE OUTER GROUNDS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.

•U18'S MUST CHECK IN WITH THEIR DESIGNATED GUARDIAN AT ALL TIMES STATED IN THE PROGRAMME AND FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN BY THE SAFEGUARDING OFFICER.

•NAME BADGES, IDENTITY CARDS, LANYARDS AND WRISTBANDS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES FOR THE DURATION OF THE RETREAT. THESE ARE ESSENTIAL FOR FIRE SAFETY.
